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



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Park the vehicle on a smooth, level, hard surface, such as concrete. Raise the blade, then turn the control OFF.
2. From the side of the blade assembly, place jack stands or sturdy blocking under the T-frame.
3. Turn the control ON and lower the blade onto the jack stands or blocking. Turn the control OFF. Turn the vehicle ignition to the "OFF" position and remove the key.
4. Orient the shoe bracket so the bracket holes align with the holes in the base angle.


NOTE: All three holes in the bracket must line up with the three holes in the base angle.

5. Insert a 5/8" x 2" cap screw through each of the two outer holes in the shoe bracket and base angle. Attach a 5/8" locknut and tighten to 150 ft-lb.



6. Repeat for the opposite side.

7. Determine the desired height of the cutting edge from the ground. Place the appropriate number of flat washers on the shoe and insert it up through the center hole in the shoe bracket and base angle. Secure with a linchpin.



8. Repeat for the opposite side.

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
